R is for RELIABLE

don't believe everything you read online, check your facts. Did you read it on a reliable website like the BBC? Are other websites saying the same thing.



TIS for TELL

If you have an online safety problem make sure you tell someone. If someone bullies you online make sure to report them and tell a trusted adult or guardian.
