


# **Pupil attainment/outcomes**

## **Fountains KS2 Y6**


For KS2 we have a scaled score, percentage and progress measure.



The scaled score for reading is 107.9 above National and the LA.




91.7% attained the expected standard in reading above National and the LA.




91.7% attained the expected standard in writing above National and the LA. There was no scaled score as there was no written test.


#### Maths - average scaled score




The scaled score for maths is 108.8 above National and the LA.




100% attained the expected standard in maths above National and the LA.



The scaled score for grammar, punctuation and spelling is 108.8 above National and the LA.



91.7% attained the expected standard in grammar, punctuation and spelling.



91.7% attained the expected standard in reading, writing and maths above the National and LA.

## **Progress measures KS1 to KS2**

### **Fountains**

Reading progress score (confidence interval in brackets) = 3.1

Writing progress score (confidence interval in brackets) = -1.0

Maths progress score (confidence interval in brackets) = 3.8

### **Interpreting progress scores**

Progress scores will be centred around 0, with most schools within the range of -5 to +5.

A **score of 0** means pupils in this school on average do about **as well** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A **positive score** means pupils in this school on average do **better** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A **negative score** means pupils in this school on average do **worse** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A negative score does not mean that pupils did not make any progress; rather it means they made less progress than other pupils nationally with similar starting points.
