Red Kite Teacher Training are one of the few providers in England offering a Part-Time route into becoming a Primary School Teacher. We recognise that for many people training to teach full-time isn't viable for a number of reasons, such as family or work commitments. We devised this programme specially with this in mind, to open the door into a rewarding career in teaching to talented people who wish to train alongside their existing commitments and make a difference in our schools.

Our 'Train Where You Live' concept makes this even more manageable, as you can now select your nearest training venue and complete placements in schools close to where you live. With two flexible options for study to choose from, this is a real opportunity to get into teaching for those who previously may not have thought it was possible.



Just like our full-time programmes, this is offered in partnership with the University of Leeds, and leads to Qualified Teacher Status and a PGCE upon completion.

Two options for study

Option One

- Train two days per week throughout the two years
- Then complete a full-time teaching practice of 8 weeks at the end of year two in term 5 and 6 (finishing in June)
- Perfect for people who need to train part-time but wish to work as a full-time teacher after graduation

Option Two

- Train two days per week throughout year one
- Train three days per week in year two (finishing in June)
- Ideal for someone who wishes to teach part-time as a teacher after graduation

Both routes cost £11,000 and are eligible for Student Loans
