Children who read for enjoyment make better progress in English and Maths. They have higher levels of knowledge and understanding and more imagination.

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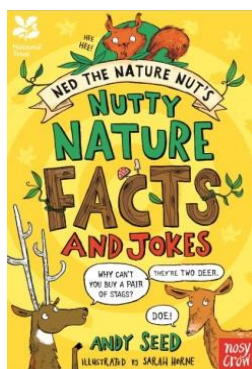
